The Fuji Brewery was founded in 1939 in the town of Izumo, Shimane prefecture, and is now managed by the 3rd generation of the Imaoka family. Izumo is famous for Izumo Taisha, a Shinto shrine built in the 8th century. This shrine is regarded as one of the oldest and most important shrines in all of Japan. In its name, this sake honors the shrine and is another symbol of Japan, Mt. Fuji.

Taste: Soft, relaxed and expansive on the palate. "Umami type" sake - flavorful and delicious, with underlying sweetness and crisp acidity.

Serve: Chilled or slightly warmed.

Pair: Grilled fish or chicken, crudité, and salty meats and cheeses.

Region: Shimane
