Made by the Fuji Brewery, which was founded in 1778, this sake is a wonderful representation of the Yamagata *ginjo* style. Unlike most *namazake* (unpasteurized sake), which are sold seasonally, this *namazake* is stored chilled and sold year-round.

Taste: Yeasty on nose; green apple and rock candy on palate; soft, fading finish.

Serve: Lightly chilled. Allow to open up; can even decant.

Pair: As aperitif, or with spicy foods.
